Q.No.1: What are the measures taken lately by the authority to conserve the Marine Ecosystem that is in danger due to Global warming and marine pollution?

The Centre for Marine Living Resources and Ecology (CMLRE) is mandated to develop management strategies for marine living resources through Ecosystem monitoring and modelling efforts, evolving, coordinating and implementing time targeted national /regional R&D programmes, and have been monitoring the ecosystems around since 1998. So far, the ecosystem in the Indian waters were explored (especially the deep sea) to the level to understand the potential living resources and the changes that are anticipated due to the changing climate, the anthropogenic influences like pollution, over exploitation etc. Having understood on the potential threat, however, still the mitigatory activities are scares other than awareness campaign that are happening at different levels to reduce the ocean/marine sector being over exploited/damaged.
